Narrative:

On April 2, 2018, at approximately 3:18 p.m., I went to the home of Billy Bob Jones located at 224 Saks Ave., Jackson, MS. I knocked on the door and Mr. Jones came to the door. I identified myself and told Mr. Jones that I would like to talk to him about what he saw next door last night when he called the police. Mr. Jones agreed to speak with me and we entered his home. Mr. Jones led me to the kitchen. Jones stated that last night he couldn't sleep. So around 11:00 p.m. he got up and went to the kitchen to get a drink and a snack. He didn't turn on the lights in the house because he has night lights on and no additional light was needed. On the way to the refrigerator a light flashing through his kitchen window caught his eye. Jones went to the window and saw two people crawling out of his neighbor's window which is across from his kitchen window. Jones led me to the window and pointed to the window on his neighbor's house that he was referring to. Jones stated that he saw two Asian males dressed in dark pants, dark shirts and dark ball caps. They were carrying dark backpacks and had flashlights. The two males were of medium build, somewhere between 5'3" – 5'5" tall, and around 140 lbs. Jones stated that the guys were moving fast. After they got out of the window, they both ran to the street and then north up the street. Jones said he could see which way they went because there is a street light at the corner of his front yard. Jones stated that is when he dialed 911 and reported what he saw.
