Here’s what will be expected of those who participate in this course:

Length of Course: Two Weeks

Time expectations: Approximately 6 hours each week.

Includes approximately 4.5 hours of independent work and a 1.5-hour group zoom meeting held on Friday each week.

Certification Credit: Yes
